Candidates with the exception for those wishing to join Bachelor in Rural Development (BRD) and Bachelor of Tourism Management (BTM) MUST in addition have at least **four passes at 'O' Level in any of the following subjects: Chemistry, Biology, Zoology, Botany, Physics, Practice of Agriculture, Mathematic, Geography and mathematics**. For BRD and BTM, candidates MUST have **four passes in arts or science subjects**. For B.Sc. Bioprocess and Post-harvest Engineering, B.Sc. (Irrigation and Water Resources Engineering) and B. Sc Agricultural Engineering, candidates must have 4 passes inclusive of **credit pass in Mathematics**.

Applicants should apply directly to SUA by filling in Application Forms that can be obtained from the Admission Office (Room No. 212 and 217 in Main Administration Building) or from our website www.suanet.ac.tz.

Application forms should be accompanied by copies of relevant certificates, two passport size photographs, a non-refundable fee of Tshs. **40,000/=**, payable through our account (**CRDB 01J1076769836**) or in the form of open Postal or Telegraphic Money Order payable to the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic).
